Privacy Policy 2024

1.0 Overview & Objective

This statement sets out Range Capital's (we, our, us, or the Company) policy on dealing with personal information. We recognise the importance of our clients' (or your) privacy and understand your concerns about the security of your personal information. We are committed to protecting any personal information about you that we hold. This Privacy Policy applies to personal information that may be collected or submitted to us through our website or via any other means of collection.

Range Capital abides by the National Privacy Principles established under the Privacy Amendment (Enhancing Privacy Protection) Act 2012 and complies with the Australian Privacy Principles contained in the Commonwealth Privacy Act 1988. Range Capital Investment Partners Pty Ltd (ABN 66 666 916 025) holds Australian Financial Services Licence No. 556150 permitting its representatives to provide general financial product advice, deal in financial products and provide custodial services to wholesale clients

2.0 Collecting Personal Information

We only collect personal information that is necessary for us to perform our functions, to develop and promote our services and to assist us with complying with our legal and regulatory obligations. As a financial services organisation, we are subject to legislative and regulatory requirements that we obtain and hold the personal information of clients. We may also collect personal information about individuals seeking employment with us. The kinds of personal information we collect and hold will depend upon the services you request from us. However, it may include information about individuals we collect while acting for clients like name, address, contact details, bank account details and tax file numbers.

We also collect information from you when you use our website. Your use of our website will determine the amount and type of information which we collect about you. Some of this information will not be personal because it will not reveal your identity. The only personal information which we collect about you when you use our website is what you provide voluntarily, for example, by sending a curriculum vitae if you are applying for employment with us or by sending us an email. We will record your email address if you send us an email.

While we take great care to protect your personal information on our website or sent via email, unfortunately no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. Accordingly, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you send to us or receive from us online. This is particularly true for information you send to us via email. We have no way of guaranteeing that information is protected in transit. Once we receive your information, we make our best effort to ensure its security in our possession. If you are concerned about providing sensitive or confidential information online, you may prefer to contact us by telephone or mail.

3.0 Cookies

Cookies are pieces of information that may be transferred to your computer's memory when you visit a website for record keeping purposes. Most web browsers are set to accept cookies. However, if you do not wish to receive any cookies you may set your Internet browser to refuse cookies or to notify you when a cookie is sent. (Each browser is different so check the "Help" menu of your browser to learn how to change your cookie preferences). We may use cookies to provide us with aggregate (anonymous) information on how people use our website and to help us know what they find interesting and useful on our website.

We do not link this information back to your identity or other information that you have provided to us. We do not store any information that identifies you inside cookies.

4.0 Use and Disclosure of Personal Information

We will not use or disclose personal information collected by us for any purpose other than:

- _i. the purposes for which it was provided or a related secondary purpose where you would reasonably expect us to use or disclose the information; or
- _ii. where you have consented to such disclosure; or
- _iii. where required or authorised under law.

We are obliged under the Corporations Act 2001 to maintain certain transaction records and make those records available for inspection by the Australian Securities and Investments Commission. In addition, we may contract external parties to conduct due diligence, compliance, or financial audits. This may involve the disclosure of your personal information.

5.0 Security, Accuracy & Storage of Your Personal Information

Irrespective of whether personal information is stored electronically or in hard copy form, we take reasonable steps to protect the personal information we hold from misuse and loss and from unauthorized access, modification, or disclosure. We do not store your information overseas. You have the right to request access to the personal information we hold about you. It is important that we use only your correct information, as such we would ask that if you find our information to be out-of-date or inaccurate could you please advise us, using the "contact details" set out below, so that corrections can be made.

6.0 Other Websites Linked to Our Site

From time to time our website may provide links to third party websites or third-party websites may link to our website. These linked sites are not under our control, and we are not responsible for the conduct of companies linked to our website. Before disclosing your personal information to any other website, you should examine the terms and conditions for using these websites and the privacy policies applicable.
